Allison Malinsky shows her sensual work in Victor Saavedra

Allison Malinsky. The works that are put together for the first solo exhibition of the New York artist in Galería Victor Saavedra have her nature in common and at the same time pictorial and sculptural and a sensual character, where the fabric is identified with skin. Malinsky has the honesty to acknowledge Sam Gilliam as one of her masters, but her way to convert painted fabric to sculpture has a distinct sense of direction. In this show we come across two types of works. Some are paintings and also wall sculptures that have a feminine sexual form and colors that evoke distinct places and elements (water, sand, vegetation, fire, sunlight, skin). And others are ceramic sculptures in the form of a women's chest, covered by voluminous paintings. All of the works question the significant changes in meaning that is produced by means of the variations of color on the same or similar form.
